Preamble:

The Government in their order cited at reference 1  
above have pooled the Special Component Plan funds of Rs. 30.16  
crores at State Sector with a view to make the Special Component  
Plan more meaningful and provide direct benefit to the Sch. Caste  
from the year 1990-91 and for the remaining period of VIIIth  
Five Year Plan. The Director of Social Welfare has been autho-  
rised to operate pooled funds and monitor the progress made  
by the various Departments and Corporations under each schemes  
and also to release the amount to the implementing agencies  
concerned as and when necessary based on the progress.

Finance Department in his order cited at reference 2  
above have released the funds of Rs. 30.16 crores from out of the  
contingency fund and placed at the disposal of the Director of  
Social Welfare, Bangalore for further action.

The Managing Director, Karnataka Sch. Caste/Sch. Tribe  
Development Corporation in his letter cited at reference 3  
above has forwarded payee's receipts amounting to Rs. 6.30 crores  
in respect of 5 schemes, for which Government has cleared the  
schemes to be taken up during 1990-91 and requested to countersign  
the payees slip.

The Managing Director, LIDKAR, Bangalore in his letter  
cited at reference 4 above has forwarded the payee's slips  
amounting to Rs. 0.30 crores along with the writeup with a request  
to countersign the payees slip.

Hence the order.

O R D E R

Sanction is hereby accorded to release a sum of  
Rs. 6.60 crores (Rs. Six crores sixty lakhs only) towards imple-  
mentation of Special Component Plan schemes as indicated in the  
Annexure appended to this order during 1990-91.

The above amount is placed at the disposal of the Managing Director, Karnataka Sch.Caste/Sch.Tribe Development Corporation and the Managing Director, LIDKAR Bangalore as per annexure for utilising the same on the schemes as per guidelines and norms of the Special Component Plan before 31-3-1991.

The amount may have to be spent for assisting within economic benefit of Sch.Castes and without diverting the funds to any other schemes. The progress on implementation of scheme is to be sent schemewise in every month not later than 5th regulary. The Sch.Caste/Sch.Tribe Development Corporation and LIDKAR has to furnish the utilisation certificates for the amount spent on approved schemes. The unspent amount if any may be surrendered to Director of Social Welfare.

The expenditure on this account is debitable to the Head of account '8000-00-239-0-00-Welfare of SCs and other BCs-2225-Welfare of SC/ST and OBCs-01-Welfare of SC-800-Other Expenditure-01-SCP for SCs-15-Employment and Training 19-Rehabilitation of Devadasis-20-Irrigation-21 water supply -22 Land Distribution'.

Preamble:-

The Chief Minister while reviewing the Special Component Plan and Tribal Sub-Plan at the meeting held on 14.8.1990 observed that the amount earmarked for the Welfare of Sch.Castes/ Sch.Tribes was not being properly utilised for the Welfare of Sch.Castes and Sch.Tribes. He therefore suggested that the interest of these sections would be better served if the entire amount reserved for the Special Component Plan is pooled at the State Level and Social Welfare Department is given the responsibility of monitoring the expenditure of this amount on schemes which would be directly beneficial for the welfare of Sch.Castes and Sch.Tribes pending decision in this regard, the Heads of Departments/under-takings spending funds under the State Sector schemes were requested to stop further spending on the Special Component Plan till the Committee took a decision on pooling and utilisation of these funds.

As desired by the Chief Minister the committee met on 31.8.1990 under the Chairmanship of the Chief Secretary and examined the issue in detail and identified the Departments in respect of which the amounts could be pooled. Hence this order.
